Précis of particulars of Casualty

*Vessel was sunk by collision in Rugsby's Reach, River Thames, on 10<sup>th</sup> February. She was raised the next day and placed alongside a derrick to discharge cargo.*

*On 15<sup>th</sup> February the Committee deferred the case for a fortnight.*

*The vessel is now being repaired under the supervision of the Society's Surveyor at this port.*

*(The usual casualty notice has not been sent to the Owner in this case.)*

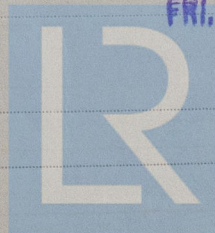
