Recis of particulars of Casualty

*Vessel was sunk by collision in Bugsby's Reach, River Thames, on 10<sup>th</sup> February.*

*She was raised the next day and placed alongside a derrick to discharge cargo.*

*The usual notice has not been sent to the Owners in this instance, but as the vessel has been submerged, the circumstances are submitted for the Committee's consideration.*

## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

**SIR GALAHAD (s).**—*Charlton*, Feb. 10, 8 14 a.m.  
 —Steamer Sir Galahad was run into and sunk last night at 12 o'clock in Bugsby's Reach by a steamer, name unknown, cargo coal.  
*Blackwall*, Feb. 10, 8 40 a.m.—At 12 15 a.m. 10th, as steamer Sir Galahad, of London, coal laden, was swinging in Bugsby's Reach, the steamer Ardle, bound up river, loaded supposed with fruit, collided with her, doing severe damage to her and causing her to sink off Manhattan Wharf, Plaistow. The Ardle proceeded up river.  
*Gravesend*, Feb. 10, 10 5 a.m.—Steamers Ardle, of Dundee, and Sir Galahad, of London, are reported to have collided early this morning in Bugsby's Hole. Former vessel proceeded to Fresh Wharf. Latter vessel is ashore at Charlton.  
**SIR GALAHAD (s).**—*Woolwich*, Feb. 11, 4 5 p.m.  
 —Sir Galahad (s), which was sunk in Bugsby's Reach, has been raised to-day by Thames Conservancy and placed alongside the derrick to discharge cargo.
