Precis of particulars of Casualty

Vessel took fire whilst lying in the South West India Dock on 25th Decr. She was sunk to extinguish the fire. She was refloated on the 28th December.

No casualty notice has been sent to the Owners.

Last Friday the Committee deferred the case for a week.

The London Surveyors have the vessel under their inspection.

Cargo is being discharged with a view to the vessel being docked. So far as yet seen there does not appear to be any doubt but that repairs will be proceeded with in the ordinary course

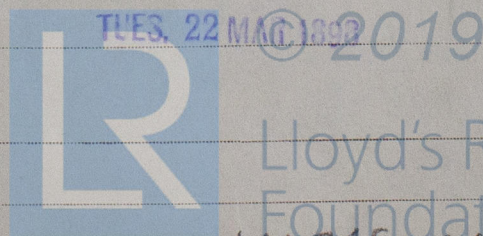
