REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Part I. S. N. 2.

Steele and bottom examined in dry dock, rudder overhauled, and the bottom cleaned and recoated; the fore peak cleaned out and recoated, the ceiling & timbers from collision bulkhead to the 4th hold stanchion before the main hatch removed, cement floor frames &c examined and found in good condition, the treon decks exam'd fore & aft, pumps overhauled, plating exam'd under sidelights, chains ranged, and equipment examined, wedges drawn and masts, spars, rigging & bowsprit overhauled. To complete the survey, the lower hull requires to be examined from the Stern to the 4th stanchion before main hatch. See owners letter as to completion of Survey.
