Damage: (alleged grounding)

Bottom sighted, cleaned & re-coated. Vessel found to have sus-
tained no damage.

Alterations:—

The bridge deck was lengthened at its after end 16
feet to form a shelter deck. Frames 6" x 3" x 7/16" bracketed to decks 4
feet apart. Side plating 3/8". Two web frames 20" x 3/8" each side.
Beams 6" x 3" x 7/16" & two pillars to each beam. Deck of yellow pine 3"
Stronger plate 26" x 7/16". Tie plates 16" x 3/8".
