The deep-plate shifting beam & light fore & afters of No. 14 hatch, on lower deck, which were bent by the weight of cargo stowed on the hatches, have been repaired.

Two double-channel pillars in No. 3 hold, which were bent, have been repaired & reinforced by the addition of side plates & thwarting heel brackets.

The fore part of <sup>wood</sup> shelter deck has been caulked, & sheathed in places with an additional thickness.
