*Kid and bottom examined in dry dock; the repair to the stem frame effected at Alexandria (as per sketch attached) examined and found to be sound and efficient, but the side bars were in my opinion too light, for a permanent repair, and I recommended bars of 5 1/2 x 5 x 1/8 to be substituted for the 5 x 5 x 1/2 bars, the owners agree to this, and after her return from a short voyage round the Coast, the owners will place her in dry dock, and carry out this alteration. The deck plating & planing immediately over the decking boiler was renewed, and the bottom cleaned and resrated.*
