This vessel encountered heavy weather last voyage, & suffered some damage to deck gear. All damage has now been repaired as follows. — Wood side-houses and companion forward rebuilt. Three beams of navigating bridge doubled. Bulwark repaired. One life boat renewed and one repaired. Bridge & upper deck recaulked and some minor repairs made.
