GRACIE (s).—*Woolwich, March 1, 2 4 p.m.*—A collision occurred in Barking Reach at 11 50 a.m. between the steamer Rosarian, of Glasgow, and steamer Gracie, of London. The Gracie now lies sunk at Tripcock Point.
Gravesend, March 1, 3 48 p.m.—Rosarian (s), from Buenos Ayres for Deptford, is reported to have collided with and sunk steamer Gracie, inward bound, cargo coals, off Beckton. Gracie is lying above Margaret Ness close in shore.
