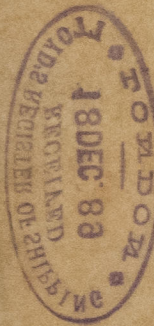
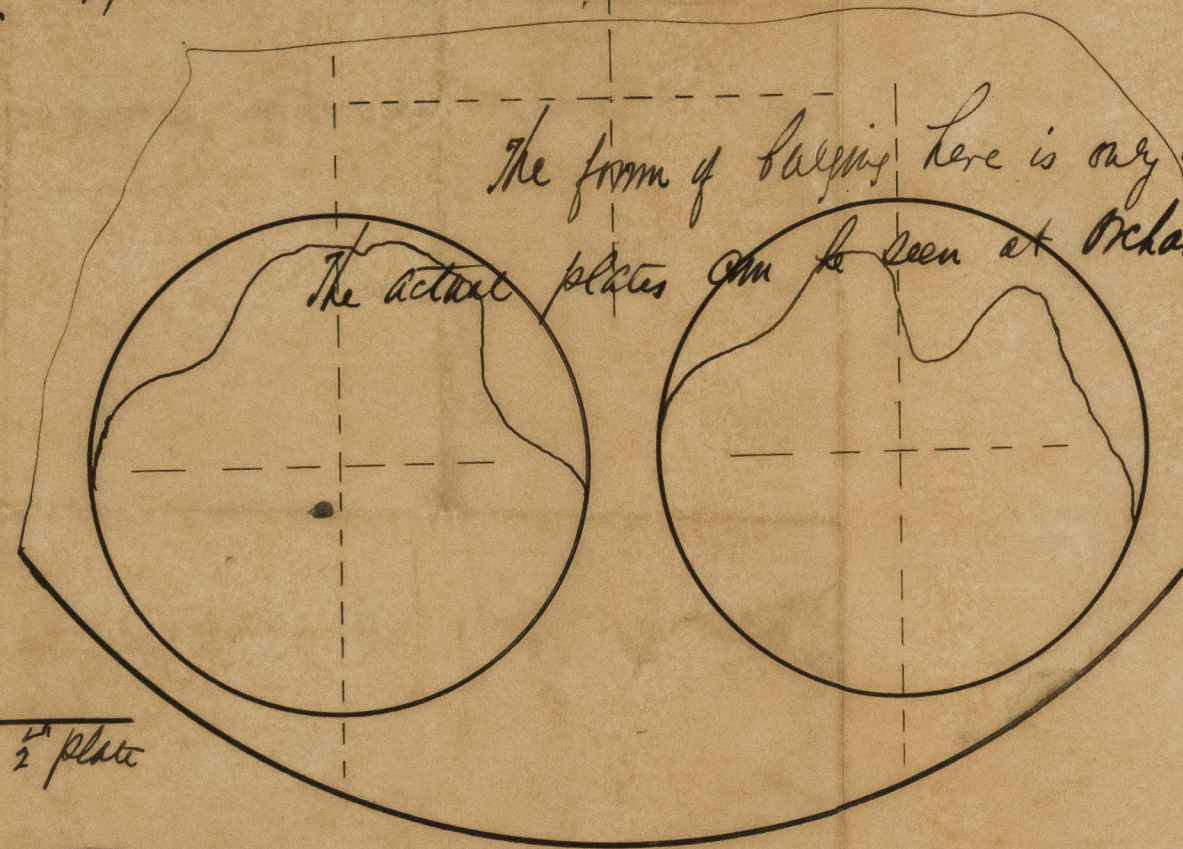
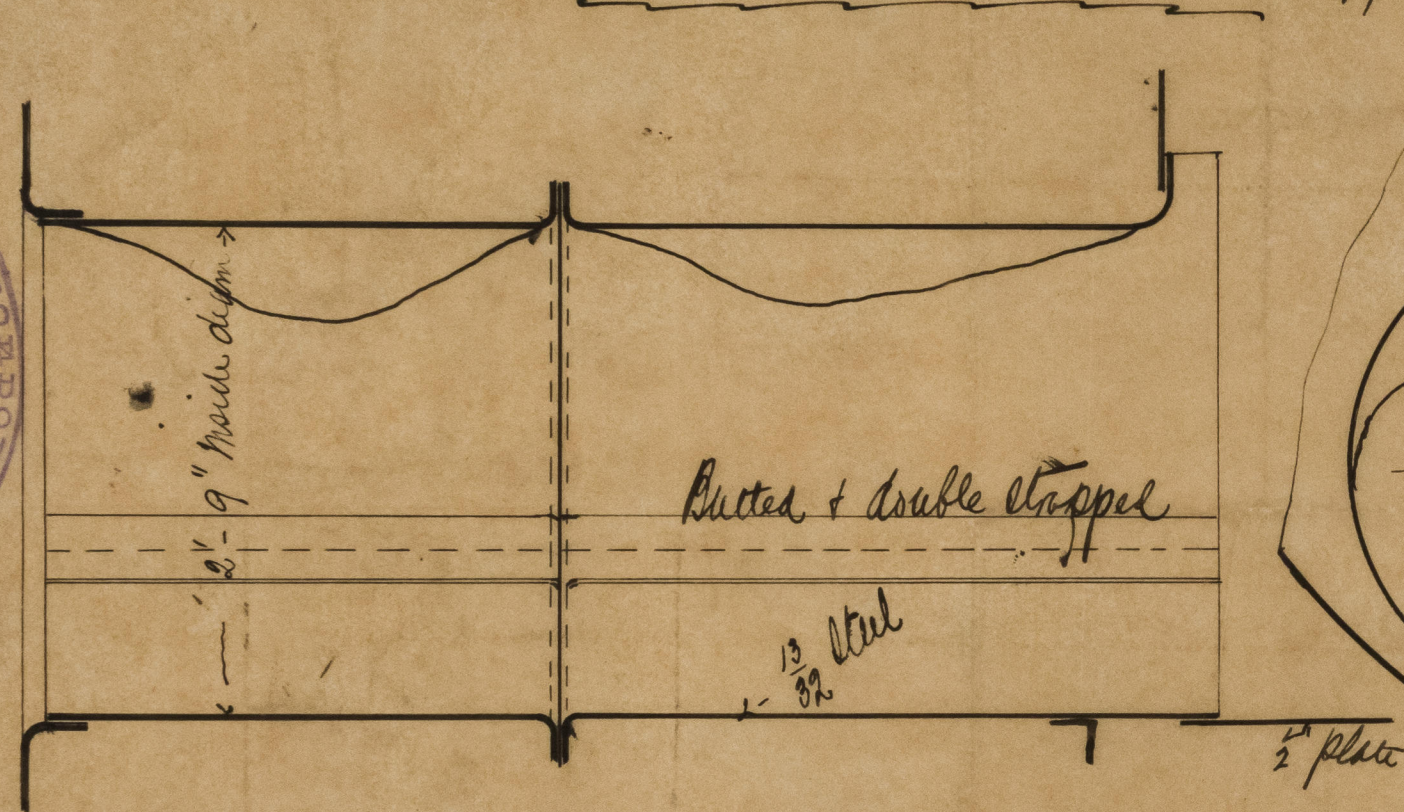

Winch Boiler Furnaces. appearance when collapsed.

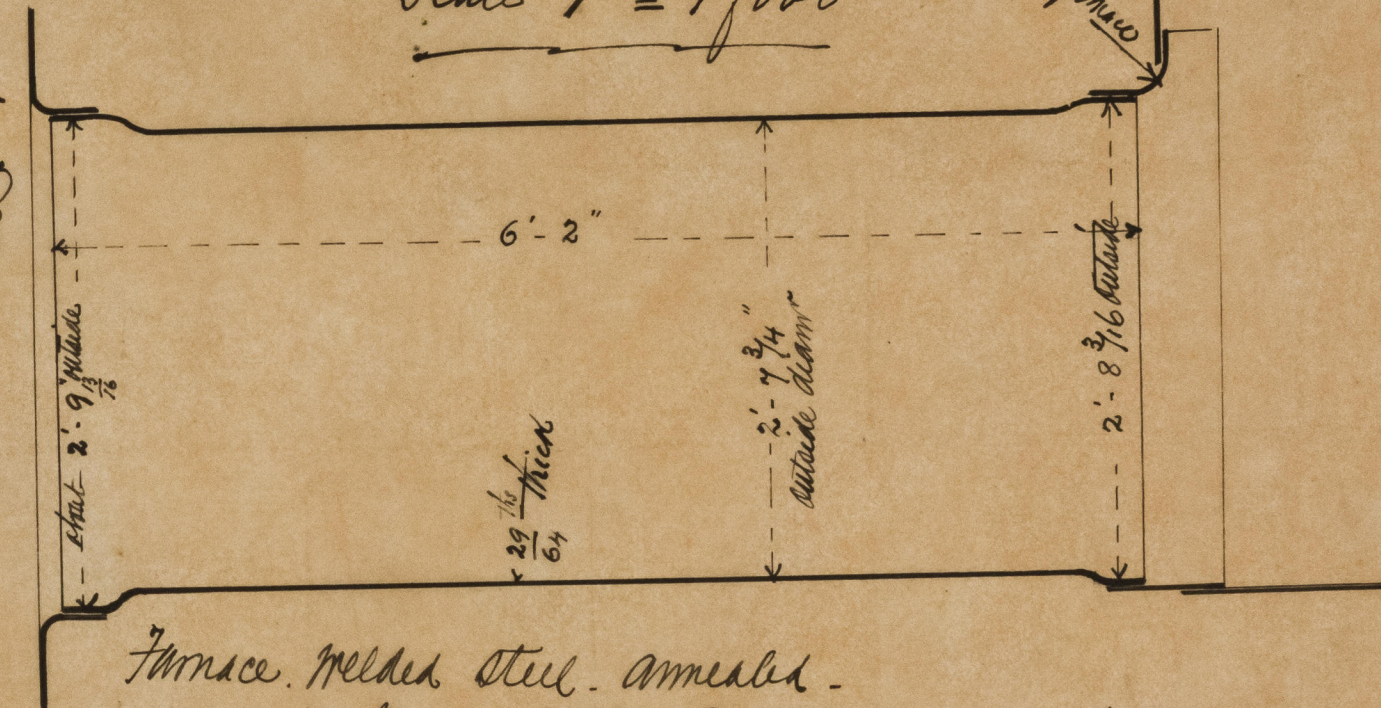

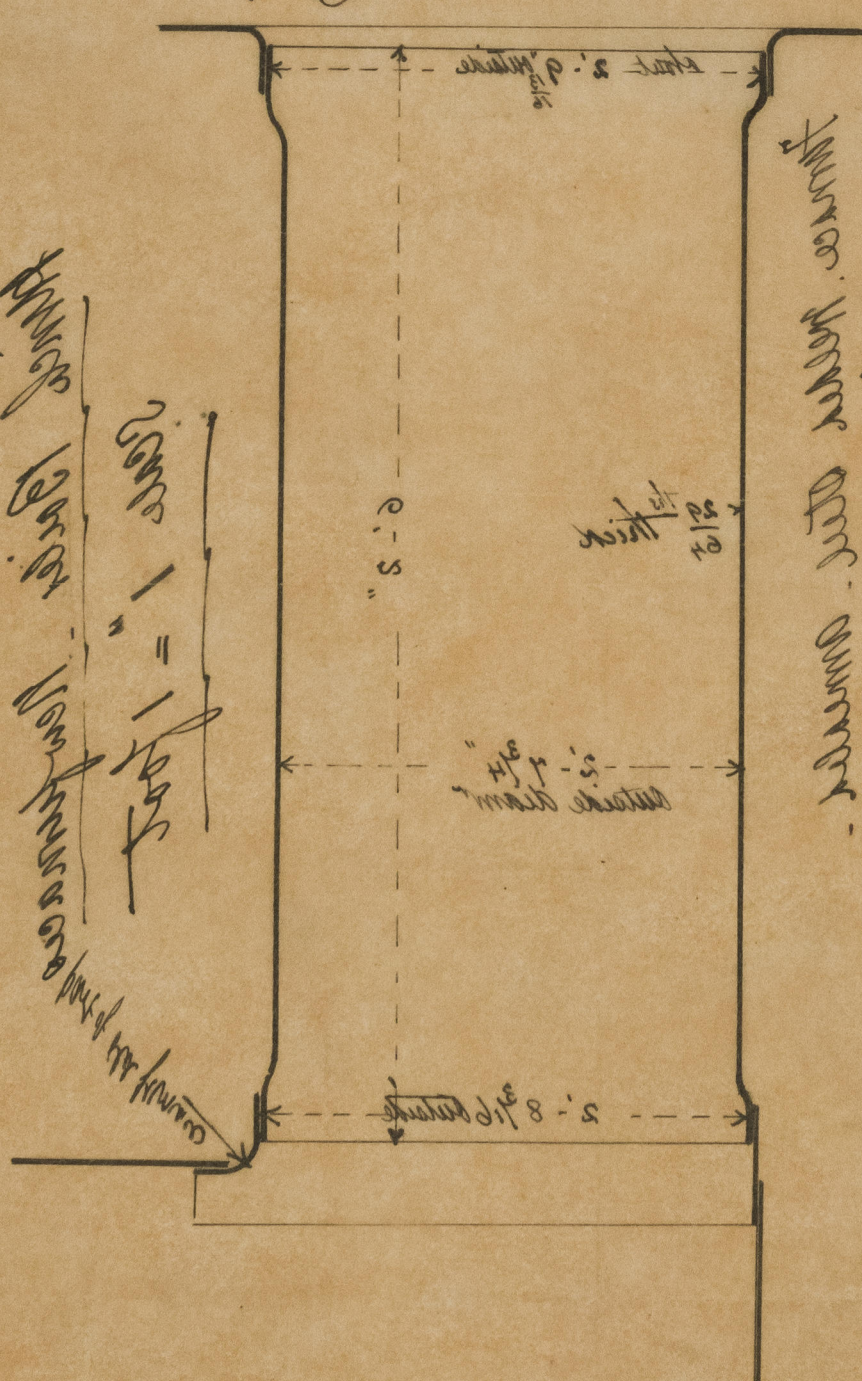
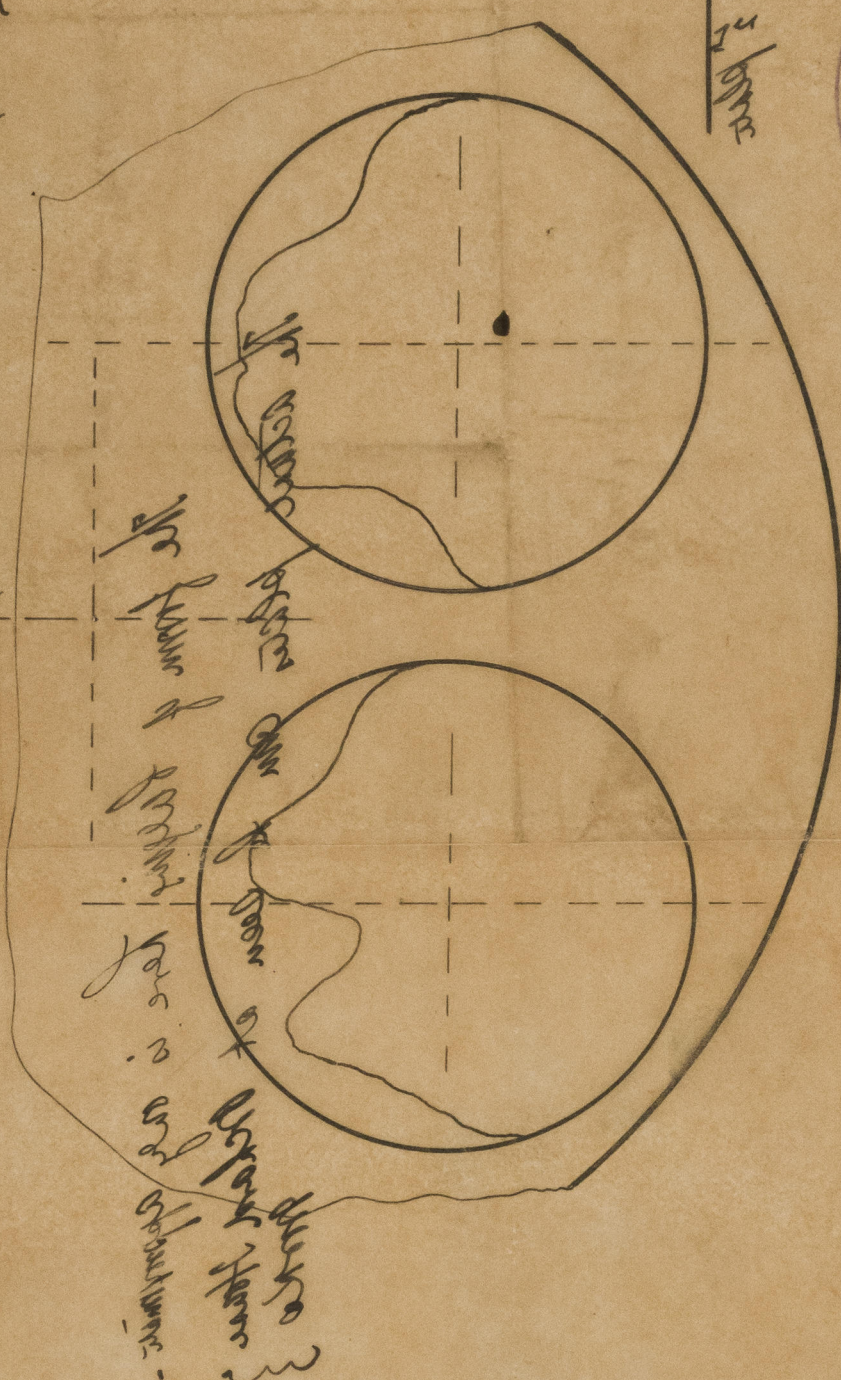
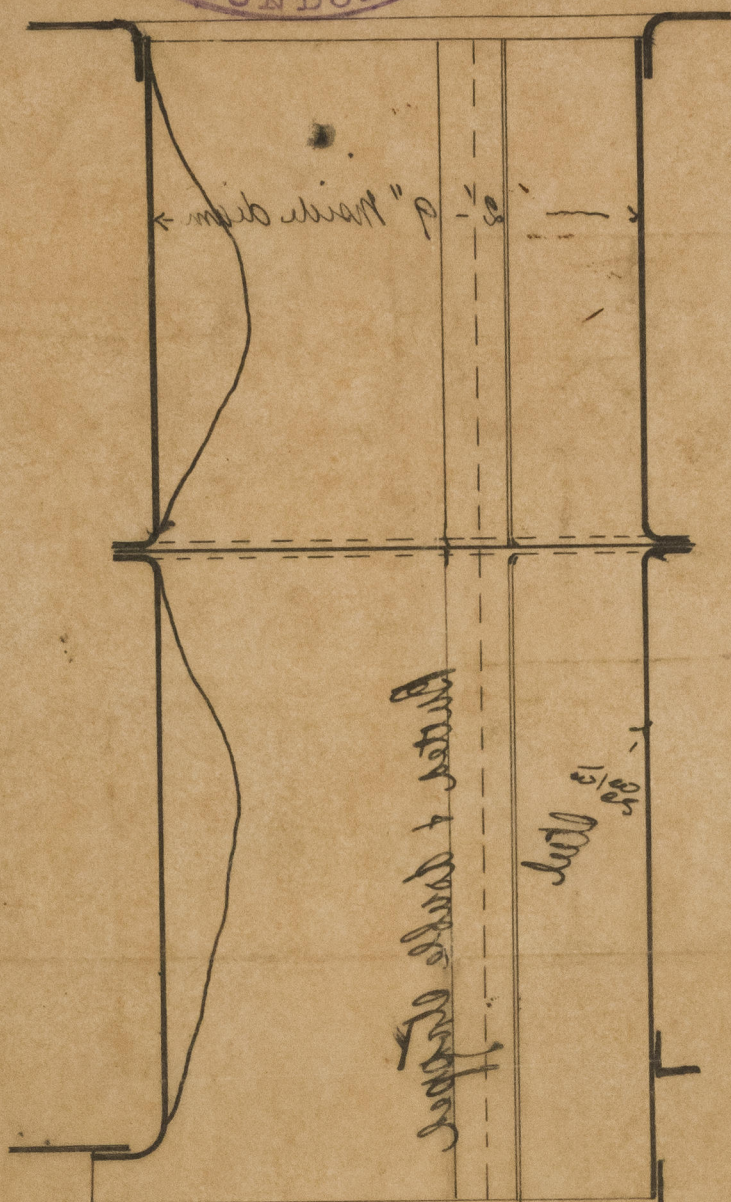
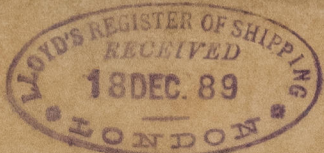
Winch Boiler. New furnaces part of old furnace
