Sir,

I have to acquaint you that I am informed by Messrs. Peirce, Becker & Ilardi, of Messina, that they have made arrangements with you to comply with the requirements of Special Survey No.3 on their steamer "CITTA DI MESSINA," upon the vessel's arrival at that port in the early part of this month. I have therefore to state that you should survey this vessel both as regards hull and machinery precisely in accordance with the requirements set forth under the heading "Survey No.3," on page 23 of the Rules for Iron Vessels, and page 77, paragraphs 48 to 52 inclusive. For your guidance I enclose extracts from the Rules referring specially to the survey in question. In reporting your survey to the Committee you should make use of the form No.2 for Repairs, headed "Report of Survey for Repairs," for the hull of the vessel, and form No.9, headed "Report of Survey for Repairs &c. of Engines and Boilers," for the machinery, and you should be careful to state clearly and in the terms of the Rules, the particulars of your examination, together with all repairs.
