Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 28th March last, respecting the Special Survey No.3 overdue on your steamer "CITTA DI MESSINA", I am directed to remind you that the Committee then agreed to allow the vessel to retain her class subject to the survey in question being held at the earliest opportunity, but no report of such survey appears to have yet come to hand.

I have therefore to repeat, that, in order to entitle the vessel to retain her class, the requirements of the Special Survey No.3 must be complied without delay, and I have to ask you to kindly let me know when and at what port you can most conveniently arrange to have this done.

At the same time, permit me to call your attention to the fact that the fee of £ 2.0.0, due for the survey held on the boilers of this vessel, has not yet been paid, and to request the favour of a remittance for the amount at your earliest convenience
