I duly received your letter of the 1st instant, submitting plans of the steel main and donkey boilers proposed to be fitted to the S.S. "Widgeon". & with regard thereto I am directed to acquaint you that these boilers will be approved by the Committee for the intended working pressure of 70 lbs. per square inch provided the steel used in their construction be tested as required by the Rules, & the boilers be built under the usual conditions of survey and testing, & in accordance with the plans as submitted, & to the entire satisfaction of the ^{Surveyor's} local Engineer Surveyor.

The plans sent are enclosed herewith, which kindly return when noted in order that they may be handed to the

local Surveyor, for his guidance in surveying the boilers during construction.
