Nature of Survey

Repairs (New Vessel)

Some rivets in shell plating just above close ceiling on S<sup>E</sup> side in No 2 hold were found to be leaking and a few rivets in same range on port side showing signs of staining

Temporary repairs have been effected to enable the vessel to return to London where, <sup>it is stated</sup> she will be docked and permanently repaired

It is submitted the Owner should be informed of the above and requested to kindly intimate when & where the vessel will be ready for survey & repairs.

In the meantime the vessel's class might be allowed to remain undisturbed in the Register Book, and when the vessel arrives in London she should be carefully examined. In the meantime the Surveyors at Belfast have been requested to furnish sketches showing the arrangement of the stringers in hold at the ends of the vessel.
