Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your BR. "HOLMENKOLLEN", I am directed to remind you that I am still without a reply to my letters of the 9th November and 16th January last, pointing out that the repairs effected to this vessel at Arendal last spring are required to be inspected by one of the Society's Officers, in order to entitle her to retain her class, and desiring to be informed when and at what port you would arrange for this examination to be made.

In view of the length of time which has elapsed since the repairs were effected, I am directed to state that unless the vessel be submitted for the necessary examination by one of the Society's Officers with the least possible delay, the Committee regret that they will have no option but to expunge her class with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules.

I shall therefore feel much obliged if you will kindly state what steps you propose to take in the matter.

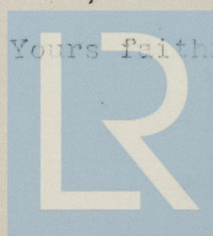
