

Memo for the Chief Surveyor.

RE BR "Holmenkollen" no 846 in AB,  
Classed Continued 5 A1 from 6, 88.

This vessel is reported in the Norwegian Veritas to have been sheathed with yellow metal in March last, & as no report was to hand from a Surveyor to this Society, the owner (Mr. N. St. Petersen of Arendal) was written to on the 25<sup>th</sup> ultimo, & asked to forward vouchers for inspection. The attached documents have been received today in regard thereto.

It was ascertained from Lloyd's Index that at the time the work in question was reported to have been done the vessel was at Arendal where she was laid up for some time, and it now appears that she put into that port "in a damaged condition where cargo was discharged & vessel repaired."

In view of the statement that damage  
repairs were effected at Aundal last  
spring after the cargo was discharged,  
it is submitted the Owner should be

of metalling in the meantime should  
be deferred until a reply has been  
received from the Owner.
