

10 miles, strong gale with heavy squalls
vessel heeling over much and shipping
water on deck windmill pumps constantly
going. At 8 o'clock Hansholmen light
bore S. E. $\frac{1}{2}$ S. distant 14 miles, nearly
pumped out from time to time during
the night. Sunday $\frac{3}{4}$ at 8.15. a pilot
came on board, steered in accordance
with his directions. At 9.30 anchored
in Arendal harbour with 30 fathoms of
chain furled the sails and pumped out
the vessel, pumps sucking at 10. P. M.
Monday the 14th at 8 o'clock there was
29 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches of water in the ship. Pumped
ship.

Then appeared as 1st witness Anders
Theodor Hilsen of Colbjørnsvig, who
said he was 21 years old and second
mate of the "Holmkollen", he was
reminded of his duties as a witness and
that perjury was punishable whereupon
he was sworn.

On examination he declared in
conformity with the extract of log.
As 2nd witness appeared Sivert Ellingsen

of Barbu and said that he was 56 years old and sailmaker on board the "Holmenkollen". He said he knew his duties as a witness, and the punishment for perjury whereupon he was sworn.

His statement regarding the vessels average was in conformity with the first witness and the log-extract, which was read for both witnesses and approved by them, they added that the vessel was tight when they commenced the voyage and that they were of opinion the water during the vessels ralling had entered through the airholes in the lower hold and got to the cargo. Both declared that it would have been imprudent to continue the voyage in the vessels then damaged condition.

Read and approved.
