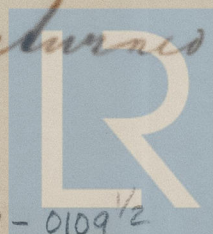

Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 22<sup>nd</sup> inst. enclosing plan of a Donkey boiler for the Sea School building by you for Messrs. Hunt, Boulton & Heywood, & in regard thereto I have to inform you that in accordance with the Rules the Donkey Boilers in all classed vessels have to comply with the Society's Rules, & a fee of £2.20 is charged for their survey during construction.

The boiler in question will be approved of by the Committee if built in accordance with the plan, for the proposed working pressure of 70 lbs per sq. inch, provided it is built under the usual conditions of survey & testing to the entire satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.
