Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your ship "BRITISH COMMODORE", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have this day had before them a report from one of the Society's Surveyors of an examination made of this vessel while lying in Deal Roads, after having been aground.

Although so far as could be seen upon examination afloat and by a diver, no damage appears to have been discovered, it is recommended that the vessel be placed in dry dock for further examination at the first opportunity, and I shall feel obliged if you will kindly let me know as soon as it has been decided when and at what port this will be done.
