Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 28th. ultimo, forwarding plans of the Steel Screw Tug No. 126, to be built by you, and beg to acquaint you in regard thereto that, provided the plans submitted, as amended, and the Rules in other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction, the vessel will be eligible to be classed A "Steel" ^{Iron} "For towing purposes".

I have also to inform you that, to entitle the vessel to the Figure 1 foreequipment, the anchors and chains must be as amended, and tested in accordance with the Rules.

I shall be glad if, in future cases, you will kindly shew the scantling numbers &c. on plans submitted.

I enclose herewith a special survey request form for this vessel, and have to acquaint you that the plan submitted is now in the hands of the London Surveyors.
