Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant, respecting your steamer "JOHN PENDER", and in reply, I beg to acquaint you that, as stated in my letter of the 30th ultimo, the only part of the Special Survey No.2 on the hull of this vessel which has been held is the examination of the bottom in dry dock.

As regards the machinery, I have to state that the adjusting of all safety valves under steam will only complete the Boiler Survey, and that to complete the Special Survey on the Machinery, the cylinders, pistons, slide valves, crank and tunnel shafting, all pumps, sea connections, arrangement of cocks, pipes, bilge suctions and roses require to be examined and (if deemed necessary) the condenser also to be examined, in addition to adjusting all safety valves under steam.

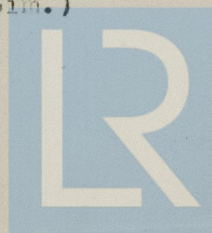
