Dear Sirs.

Reverting to my letter of the 28th November last, informing you that it was necessary for one of the Society's Surveyors to carry out the Special Survey No.1, including the damage, required in the case of your steam tug "NARCISO DEULOFEU" in order to entitle the vessel to retain her class in the Society's Register Book, and suggesting whether you might be able to arrange with Mr. Turley, the Society's non-exclusive Surveyor at New Orleans to make the necessary inspection, I am directed to remind you that the survey in question has not yet been held and that, in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Special Survey No.1 expired so long ago as October last, arrangements must be made for the survey to be held and the damage repairs to be inspected by one of the Society's Surveyors without further delay, as otherwise the Committee regret they will be unable to allow the vessel to retain her class.

I shall therefore be much obliged if you will kindly let me know in the course of post what steps you propose taking in the matter.
