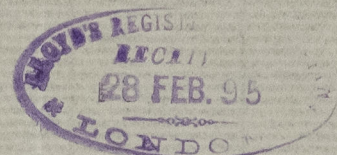

Dear Sir:-

Your favor of Dec. 14th through A. K. Miller & Co., duly received. In reply, I would state at this season of the year that my engagements are such that it is impossible for me to come to Havana.

I inclose a copy of the requirements of Lloyds for the special Survey No. 1, and in addition thereto, the examinations of the engines and boilers must be complete and carefully done. Boilers must be tested to a pressure of 175 lbs. by water, to insure the record of steam you now have of 150 lbs. The damages by fire must be fully stated to me and all repairs stated in detail. These requirements can be performed or supervised by any competent and reliable persons whom you choose to employ.

A copy of all papers in relation to these matters, properly attested, to before a notary, will warrant my recommending the Committee of Lloyds Register to continue the vessel's class as now notated 100 A-I. My charges, individually, will be about fifty dollars.
