Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 7th instant, respecting the case of the Steam Tug. "NARCISCO DEULOFEU", and in reply, I am directed to acquaint you that in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Special Survey No.1 on this vessel expired in October last, it will be necessary for a Surveyor to this Society to carry out the Special Survey, including the damage repairs, in order to the retention of the vessel's class in the Register Book, and that although Mr. Tyrley, the Society's non-exclusive Surveyor at New Orleans is not directed in his movements by the Committee, still it is considered that you might arrange with him for the carrying out of the Special Survey No.1 and for the inspection of the repairs of damage by fire.
