I have received a letter from Mr. Woodhouse, the Resident Engineer of the above Company, in which he says that it is impossible to send the S. S. "Higuerote" to Barbadoes at present as they are in the height of the cocoa season and both the Higuerote and Paparo are as busy as can be and expect to be till May is over, but that then the Higuerote will have to go to Martinique for repairs and could go on from there to Barbadoes. I have informed the new Dutch Company of my intention to have the Higuerote surveyed, but as I gather

from Mr. Woodhouse's letter that the cost of a trip to Barbadoes for the purpose of survey would be £200, the new company will have to consider for themselves the desirability of having such survey carried out.
