Dear Sir,

With reference to my letter of the 13th ultimo respecting the case of the Steamer "HIGUEROTE", I have the pleasure to acquaint you that the Committee have appointed Captain H.J.Fox as the Society's Surveyor at Barbadoes. Captain Fox will leave England at the end of this month to take up his duties, and I shall therefore feel obliged if you will kindly apply to him with a view to the carrying out of the Special Survey No.1, now long overdue on the above mentioned vessel.

I may add that if it would be more convenient to you to have the inspection carried out at Martinique I have no doubt that you could make arrangements with Captain Fox to attend to the matter at that port.

As the survey in this case is now no less than 16 months overdue, I shall be obliged if you will make the necessary arrangements for the same to take place with as little delay as possible.
