Dear Sir,

Reverting to my letter of the 23rd March last, respecting the case of your steamer "HIGUEROTE", I beg to acquaint you that it appears from a letter which has been received from the Society's Surveyor at Barbadoes that no steps have yet been taken as regards the Special Survey of this vessel and that your Manager, who has left for Europe, has informed the Surveyor that the steamer cannot go to Barbadoes for survey until his return at the end of June, and the Surveyor expresses the hope she may be there by that time as he himself expects to be leaving on a visit to England in July.

Under the circumstances, I am directed to acquaint you that in view of the survey being so very long overdue it must be held before the end of June, as otherwise the Committee will have no option but to expunge the vessel's class without further notice.
