Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "BOLDERRAA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them this day a report of the survey which has recently been held on this vessel's boilers by the Society's Surveyors here.

It appears that owing to the donkey boiler being found defective, it has been decided to fit a new one, and I shall feel obliged if you will kindly let me know when and at what port you propose to have this done and the safety valves of the main boilers adjusted under steam, in order to complete the Annual Special Survey which became due in August last.

I have to add that action in regard to the case has been deferred by the Committee subject to the old donkey boiler not being used again.
