Portion of Survey held, &c.

The S.S.No.3 due 5,95 was held in December last with exception of the examination of the frames and plating above the bilge stringers on each side in the fore and after holds and the removal of close ceiling at these parts and testing of after peak tank.

The Owners in reply to enquiry state that they were unable to complete the survey during the vessel's recent stay in London but they propose to do so on her return before the end of May next when the year of grace expires, and trust this will meet with the Committee's approval.

It is submitted that this proposal merits the favourable consideration of the Committee and the vessel's class might in the meantime be allowed to remain undisturbed.

It is submitted that the Local Engineer Surveyors be asked to report on the case
