Lloyd's Agent, I on the 3^d day of September, repaired on board the British Barque Indian Empire laying at the Port of Callao for the purpose of surveying the Masts, Spars & rigging of said vessel and after a careful examination of the same I found them in a good and strong condition well fitted to my entire satisfaction.

I moreover declare that on the 4th day of September 1896 I surveyed the hull, boats, Sails, Anchors & chains and fittings for the accommodation of the master & crew and after a careful examination of same I found the whole in a thoroughly good condition and it is my impartial opinion that the Barque Indian Empire is in a seaworthy condition and in a fit state to proceed to Europe.


