Nature of Survey *Re-instatement of class & Continuation Survey No 2.*

This vessel was originally classed 9A-, which was withdrawn at the Owners' request in 1894.

The Continuation Survey No.2, per section 54 of the Wood Rules has now been held, and the following repairs due to wear and tear effected;- One beam, coamings, framing and deck in way of Boiler space, renewed, keelson under boilers repaired and minor repairs effected.

It is submitted the vessel appears eligible to have her class 9A- reinstated in the Register Book, with record of survey 3.97.Lyn, and to be continued on the A character for 6 years from 2.98, that is at the expiration of her original class.
