The S.S.No.2 due 1,95 ~~was~~ held at Danzig with the exception of some repairs to the floors under the boilers and the bunker bulkheads, has now been completed and the following repairs done:- 6 floors under the boilers renewed, and double reverse bars fitted to others. The lower part of stokehold bulkhead, the bunker bulkheads and lower deck stringer in bunkers repaired, the main and bridge decks overhauled and minor repairs effected,

Some damage through ice reported in February 1897 as temporarily repaired has been permanently repaired as follows:- 3 plates and some keel rivets renewed and minor repairs.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain classed ~~A1~~ with record of survey 5,97 Lon. and the notation S.S.Dnz. No.2,95 as recommended.
