I have just received a letter from my Manager at Mazatlan in which he informs me that the slip at Guaymas has now been turned over to the Government, and that he has at once advised Lloyd's agent at Mazatlan asking him to appoint a competent person to examine this boat.

He mentions that the boat was thoroughly overhauled in September, one new plate was fixed on the hull, new pistons were fitted to the pumps, new tubes in the condenser, and new bulk-heads were also fitted. The hull was well scraped inside and out, but the new keel plate was not put on as the slip was in bad condition, and it was feared that some serious damage might be occasioned to the steamer.
