I am duly in receipt of your letter of the 19th ultimo enclosing a report of a Survey held upon the steam tug "ALTATA", and with regard thereto, I am directed to convey to you the Committee's thanks for your attention in the matter.

With reference to the Surveyor's recommendation in regard to the renewal of the keel plates, I beg to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a communication from the owners, in which it is stated that the new plates are being shipped from Liverpool on the 23rd instant, and will be put in position as soon as possible after arrival.

I shall therefore be obliged if you will kindly appoint a competent Surveyor to see these repairs carried out, and forward a report to me in due course.
