Torre Annunz<sup>to</sup> 16 June 1905

Dear Mr. Romeo

According to what you stated to me the day before yesterday in respect to the Survey to be held on the SS Elena D. as you told me, you make me understand that you have been directly interested by the owner of the steamer to survey her at Messina in consequence of the repairs to which said steamer had to be submitted in that Port and in this way I wired to our Committee at London

- "Elena D 274 is to be docked next Sunday at Messina
- require to be examined for re-classification May
- I hold 2nd SS No. 3 on this vessel at her master
- request.

To this telegram the Lloyd's replied as follow

- Owner's Agent states already arranged survey
- will be held on her arrival at Genoa.

Then as you will see previous arrangements have been concluded between the Agent and Lloyd, consequently I appeared in this matter as an interested.
