S. With reference to the case of the Steamer "ELENA D" I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyor at Naples has reported by cablegram that this steamer is at the present time in drydock at Messina and this being the case the Surveyor has been authorised to make an examination of the bottom in drydock if desired by the Owners to do so.

I shall, however, be obliged if you will kindly make it quite clear to the Owners ^{that} in accordance with the intimation already given to them the remainder of the Second Special Survey No.3 of this vessel necessary for the reinstatement of the steamer upon her original classification must be held by one of the Society's Exclusive Surveyors, either at Genoa, Marseilles, Constantinople or at some other port where an Exclusive Surveyor is stationed, and perhaps you will kindly let me know what arrangements they propose making in the matter.
