Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of yesterday's date, respecting the steamer "ELENA D.", ex "SWAN", and note your remarks.

With regard thereto I beg to acquaint you that in order to render the vessel eligible for the reinstatement of her character in the Society's Register Book it will be necessary for the requirements of the Second Special Survey No. 3 to be fully complied with and for the vessel and her equipment to be favourably reported upon to the Committee. This survey must be carried out by an Exclusive Officer to the Society, and as the Society's Surveyor at Braila is not an Exclusive Surveyor the survey could not be held at that port unless an Exclusive Surveyor were sent there.

I enclose herewith for your information a list of surveying ports in which you will find underlined in red ink the ports at which Exclusive Surveyors are stationed.
