Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 3rd December last addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Lyttleton, relative to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your bk. "HELEN DENNY", I am directed to remind you that the year of grace allowed by the Society's rules for the completion of the Special Survey No.3 expired so long ago as July last, and that you promised to carry out the inspection in question on the vessel's return to Sydney from the voyage she was then undertaking.

Under the circumstances I am directed by the Committee to state that unless the survey has been completed in Australia before she proceeded on her present voyage to Honolulu, they will have no option but to expunge the vessel's class in the Society's Register Book with a red line, indicating non compliance with the Society's rules.
