In January last the Surveyor at Lyttleton enclosed a letter from the Owner in which it was stated that the survey in question would take place on the vessel's return to Sydney. She was then on voyage to San Francisco and would return direct on the completion of her loading.

The Surveyor at Sydney writing on the 20th April last stated that as it appeared from the newspapers that the vessel was bound to Adelaide, he had forwarded a duplicate of the Secretary's letter of instructions to the Society's Surveyor at that port. The Surveyor at Adelaide now writes that he interviewed the master who informed him that there was no intention to have the vessel surveyed at that port, but that she was going on to Sydney and that if anything was done it would take place there.

No report has been received from the Surveyor at Sydney and the vessel left Newcastle N.S.W. on the 14th August for Honolulu.

It is submitted that the Owner be communicated with and informed that the year of grace expired so long ago as July, and reminded that he promised to carry out s.s.No.3 on the vessel's return to Sydney, and that unless the survey has been completed in Australia before proceeding on her present voyage, the class of the vessel in the Society's R.B. will be expunged with a red line, indicating non compliance with the Society's rules.
