Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 22nd. inst., enclosing an amended plan of the boiler you are about to construct for the S. Tug "MERRINAC", and with regard thereto I am directed to acquaint you that the scantlings as now shewn, meet the requirements of the Rules for a working pressure of 80 lbs per square inch, and the same will be approved by the Committee for this pressure, provided the shell plates have a tensile strength ranging from 27 to 32 tons per square inch, and the boiler be built under the usual conditions of survey and testing and to the entire satisfaction of the Society's local Engineer Surveyor.

The plan referred to has been retained for the guidance of the Surveyor during construction.
