Memorandum (Petition)

In case of John James & Son  
Grillwall (Boiler Works) based in Surrey  
during construction of new Furnace  
(Boiler intended to be fitted to the  
Horse 12 1/2 H.P. engine)

The Material and Workmanship on  
examination were found to be good  
and satisfactory.

On completion of the work the above  
Boiler was tested by water pressure to One  
Hundred and Sixty Pounds per Square inch  
(N.B. lbs) and found good at that pressure.

The following Mark was stamped on Boiler: -  
M. J. & L. J. D. 1899. No. 28. 3. 11.

This Boiler is in my opinion eligible to  
be carried to a steam working pressure not  
exceeding Eighty Pounds per Square inch.
