construction, I have received Briles
supplied by Messrs. The Standard Iron
Works, Blackwall, London, for
the London Survey, "River" of London.
908 tons gross weight of iron.
The material and workmanship
of this Briles are found to be
good and satisfactory.
On completion this Briles was
tested by water pressure to two hundred
and sixty pounds per square inch
and found to be tight and sound at
that pressure. The following
Mark was stamped on this Briles
No 67 Lloyd's Test - Dec 6th 1899.
In my opinion this Briles is of sufficient
at a pressure of one hundred and thirty pounds
(130 lb) per square inch.
