provided the tensile strength of the shell
plating ranges from 27 to 32 tons per sq. inch;
the steel to be used in the construction of the boiler be
tested as required by the Rules, and the boiler be built and
tested in accordance with the plan submitted and with the
provisions of the Rules, and to the entire satisfaction of the
local Engineer Surveyor, it will be approved of for the
intended working pressure of 80 pounds per square inch.
