I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28th. inst., submitting for the Committee's approval an amended plan of the donkey boiler to be built by you for the S.S. "ELECTRA", and with regard thereto I am directed to acquaint you that provided four additional screw stays be fitted at the back end of the boiler; the screw stays at the sides of the combustion chambers be made .86 sq. inches effective area; the plan in other respects be adhered to, and the boiler be built under the usual conditions of survey and testing and to the entire satisfaction of the Society's local Engineer Surveyor, the same will be approved by the Committee for the intended working pressure of 85 lbs per square inch.

The plan referred to is returned herewith, which after noting, kindly forward again for the Surveyor's guidance during construction.
