Dear Sir, we have received notice
that your agent here is instructed not to survey
more of our vessels built here until the
fee of your Engineer Surveyor at Shields is paid.
The "Emerald", we duly paid the fee on
Hull as formerly & we were never before
informed that we were liable for the Engineers
& you have classed for us the hulls of the
Puffin, "Dunlin", "Alice", "Pioneer", "British Prince", &
"Emerald"; the Owners supplied the machinery & had
their own surveyor of their own hence they refuse
to pay your surveyor for machinery at Shields.
He did not instruct any one to survey machinery
he must have done so on his own accord.
Now you see the fault is not ours & we
trust you will not deal so hard with us.
