Sir, I am in receipt of your letter of the 9th instant, respecting the case of the steamer "Emerald", and in reply I have to acquaint you that the signature of the Master to the form of request for survey necessarily renders them liable for the payment of the fees for the survey of machinery, unless the portion relating thereto is struck out, in which case a separate request for the survey of the machinery signed by the Engineer or Owner will be required.

I have therefore to request that you will make application to the Surveyors for payment of the fees for the survey of the machinery

of the steamer "Emerald".

I have to add that in any case until the machinery fees are paid no entry of the vessel's class can be made in the Register Book.
