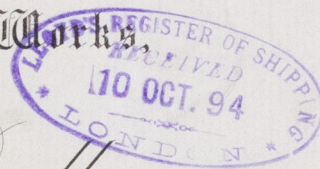

Re Outfit No 131.,

Dear Sirs:-

I have your favor enclosing letter from Lloyds Surveyor referring to the weight of the Head used in the small Anchor as weighing only 9.0.19., this is a mistake as he has overlooked the weight of the Box which fits in the Head also the Pin which keeps it in its place, these bring up the weight to 10.1.1., which is about $\frac{1}{2}$ cwt short of three-fifths, but as the other two Anchors have the Heads &c about 2 cwt in excess of the requirements, I feel sure that Lloyds Committee will overlook the small difference in the one Anchor, as it would have delayed the Steamer at least a month to have waited for another to have been cast, hoping this explanation will be satisfactory.

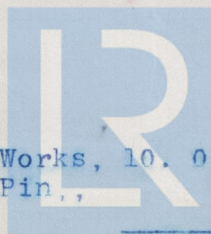
