Herewith I beg to submit a list of the 3 stockless Dover Anchors supplied to S. S. "Benhead" (No 90) now on the stocks & nearly completed at Messrs. J. Scott & Co's yard, Kinghorn, from which will be seen that the 3<sup>rd</sup> anchor is not quite of the weight req'd. & I shall be glad to receive instructions whether same will be approved. - As explained by the manufacturers, whose two letters addressed to Messrs. J. Scott & Co are enclosed, the weight of the bolt attaching head to shank is 1<sup>lb</sup>. 14 lbs., which added to the head gives <sup>total 80 lbs.</sup> 16. 1. 22. & consequently less than  $\frac{3}{5}$  of  $29\frac{3}{4}$  cwt. req'd. by the Rules. -
