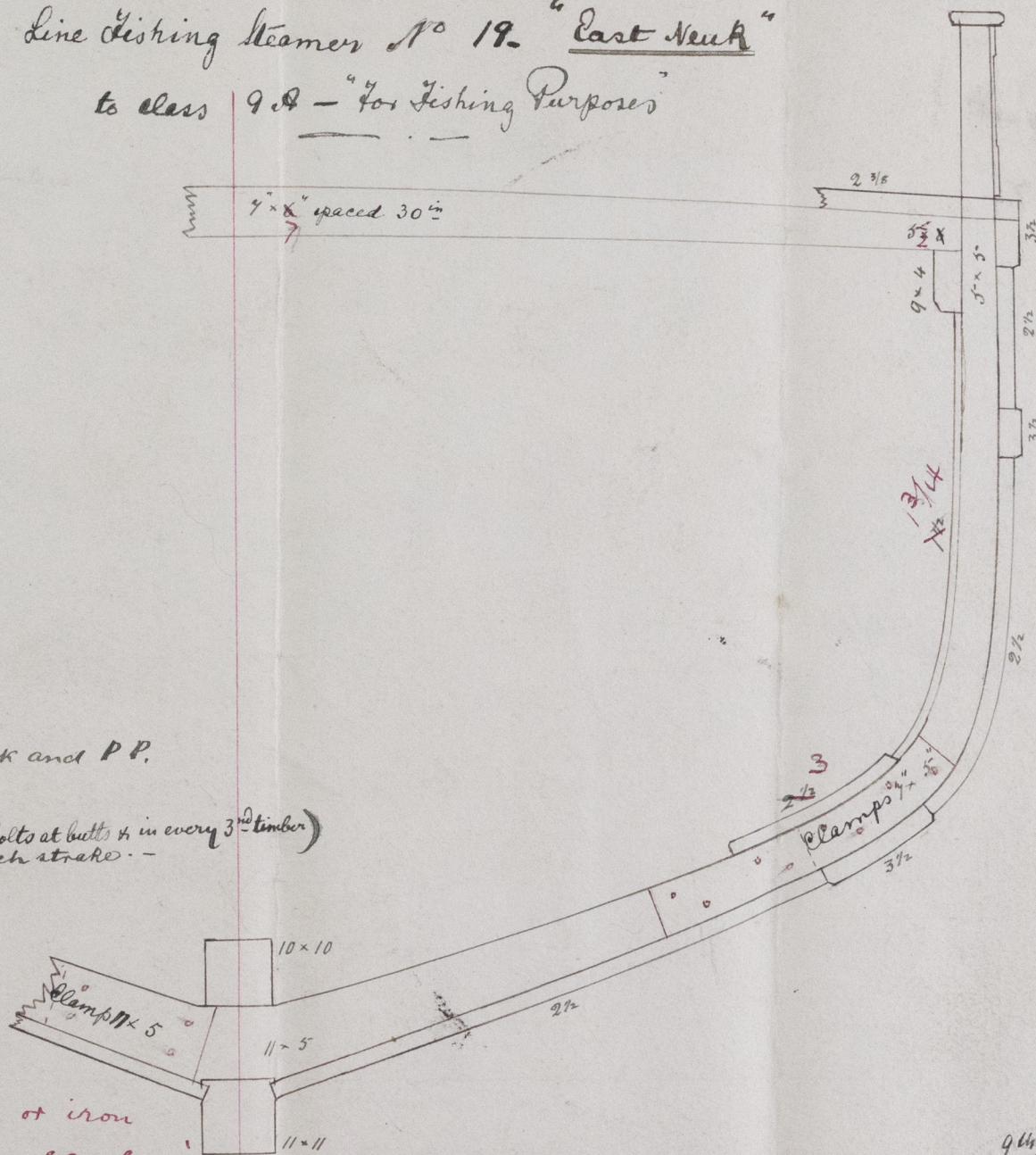

8 pairs long rider knees on each side.



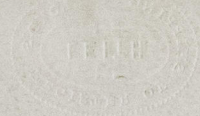
