

Three Steam Trawlers No 56, 57 & 59
built by Messrs Stawthorns & Co at
Leith to Class 100 A. Steam Trawler.

These vessels are of the same dimensions
as their No 51 the "Chancellor"
No 430 in the Register Book, and
are stated to be in every respect
duplicates of that vessel excepting
that the new vessels have slightly
more sheer forward, which increases
the tonnage under deck from 99 tons
to 105 tons, and consequently by Table
22 would require larger anchors and
chains.

Through a misunderstanding on the part
of the builders who assumed that the
anchors and chains required would be
the same for these vessels as for No 51
previously built of the same dimensions, the
anchors and chains have been supplied
in accordance with the Scale for 80 tons
under 100 tons as in the former vessel and
two of the new vessels have left with
them on board.

Under these circumstances the Builders
desire that the equipment as supplied
be approved, and it is submitted this
request might receive the favorable
consideration of the Committee, provided
the Owners sanction be obtained to the
same, and the case be not taken as
a precedent.
